The Victorian Government has extended the State of Emergency in response to the coronavirus pandemic until 11.59pm on Sunday 19 July 2020. Restrictions have been tightened in some areas of Melbourne. Stay home if you are unwell and get tested if you are experiencing any symptoms of coronavirus.
