- The cricket nets are complete and have been handed over to the North Castlemaine Cricket Club.
- Completion of asphalt courts 4-6 and landscaping is scheduled for end March 2018.
- An official opening is to be scheduled for autumn 2018.

The stage one package of works is funded by \$1.9 million from the Australian Government's Community Development Grants Programme.
