CASTLEMAINE HEALTH

Provide activity groups to help people make friends and connections in their community. These include trips and outings, and are for people aged over 65, or over 50 if Aboriginal or/and Torres Strait Islander.

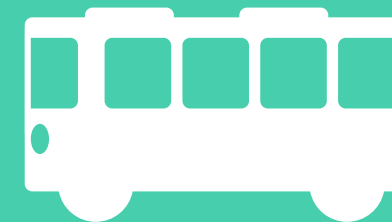

NEWSTEAD & DISTRICT COMMUNITY BUS SERVICE

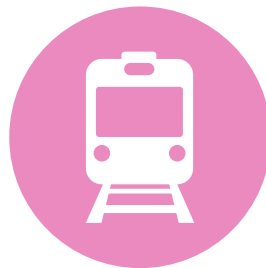
The Newstead Rural Transaction Centre (RTC) runs a community transport service for residents of Newstead, Guildford, Welshman's Reef, Strangways and Yapeen for transport to Castlemaine and Maryborough. All trips must be booked in advance by calling the RTC. The bus is also available for charter.
