Wesley Hill Recreation Reserve Redevelopment Stage 1 – March 2017

Construction works for Stage 1 of the Wesley Hill Masterplan are well underway and the visual change to the landscape is remarkable.

Stage 1 will see the construction of:

- Six new netball courts: 3 acrylic, 3 asphalt
- Two synthetic practice cricket nets
- Conversion of netball courts to carpark
- Paved walkway and steps from carpark to netball courts.



Works underway include:

- Excavation for the 3 asphalt netball courts
- Earthworks for the access road
- Earthwork and levelling for the ramp and stairs to the 3 acrylic courts, along with preparation for drainage to these courts
- Preparation for construction of cricket practice nets; and
- Trees were removed from the site to allow for the new netball courts.

It is anticipated that the asphalt courts will be ready for use by the end of April 2017 with the entire project due for completion by the end of 2017.
