

Project Bulletin 2

Wesley Hill Recreation Reserve Redevelopment Stage 1 – April 2017

Construction works continue at Wesley Hill Recreation Reserve, with the redevelopment works tracking on schedule.

Stage 1 construction of the netball courts is progressing well. Works undertaken to date include:

- Drainage works around the netball courts 90% complete
- Concreting of footpaths adjacent to the asphalt netball courts
- 80% of excavation completed for the acrylic netball courts
- Kerbing of the emergency access road
- Concreting of access ramp and stairs from parking level to access road
- Preparation of the base for cricket nets and fence post installation



Works to take place in April and May include:

- Completion of drainage works around all netball courts
- Sealing of the emergency access road
- Construction of cricket net fencing and concrete base.
- Asphalt surfacing of 3 netball courts

It is anticipated that the asphalt courts will be completed by the end of May 2017 and cricket nets will be completed in June 2017. The entire project is due for completion by the end of 2017.
