Wesley Hill Recreation Reserve Redevelopment

Stage 2 – April / May 2018

Stage 2 works commenced in April 2018 with a sod turning event officiated by Maree Edwards MP and Mayor Bronwen Machin. Stage 2 will provide a multi-purpose pavilion with female friendly facilities for football, netball and cycling.



Progress to date:

- Demolished existing clubrooms
- Site excavation for required levels
- Concrete pour for retaining wall and subfloor slab
- Installed in-ground storm water and sewer
- Existing in-ground power has been lowered.
- Installed football oval light conduits

The project is tracking on schedule with an estimated completion date of December 2018.

Total project costs for stage two are \$2.33m with \$2.23m to be funded by Mount Alexander Shire Council and \$100,000 from Victorian Government via the Community Sports Infrastructure Fund – Female Friendly Facilities stream.
