

Maldon Streetscape Revitalisation Project

Project update – Friday 10 June 2022



The weather has impacted our ability to carry out some works in Maldon this week, slowing the progress of our plans to repair the stone drains and footpaths in town.

We are continuing to focus our efforts in this area though, despite the weather, and are concentrating on repairing the stone drains along High Street, between Poppy's of Maldon and the Old NSW bank building.

Thanks for your cooperation during night works

This week we completed roadworks to replace the road surface along the car-parking strip on High Street, between Fountain and Spring streets.

To minimise disruption to local businesses, works were undertaken between 6.00pm and 6.00am.

We understand that there may be some disruption while works were underway, and tried to minimise the impact of these works on residents and businesses by undertaking works at night, in small sections.

We appreciate your support, patience and cooperation while our team carried out these important improvements.

Next week's priorities

Following the stone drain works, we will be laying new asphalt from Poppy's of Maldon to the Old NSW bank building.

Stone drain works will continue on High Street west, from the Old NSW bank building toward Robert Cox Motors, subject to weather conditions.

The drain bridge replacement continues, with old timber bridges in place until the new bridges are completed.

Background on Maldon Streetscape Revitalisation Project

Works are progressing in Maldon on the [Maldon Streetscape Revitalisation Project](#) – a long-term initiative to rejuvenate the historic town.

The project has three main areas:

- putting powerlines underground
- restoring shopfronts
- upgrading public spaces such as footpaths, road surfaces, drains, bins and seating.
