Works underway in Maldon

The Maldon Streetscape Revitalisation Project is an exciting initiative that aims to rejuvenate Maldon's historic streetscape.

Latest news

Council is moving forward over February and March with the following works, weather permitting:

- Completion of High Street pedestrian crossing
- Installation of drinking fountain on High Street
- Installation of custom-made bins outside Maldon Bakery, Maldon Takeaway, IGA and Old Bank Corner
- Installation of wayfinding signage.

The replica gas light proposed for Old Bank Corner will no longer be installed following discussions with the steering committee about reducing visual clutter on the corner.

Project summary to date

The project has three main areas – putting powerlines underground, restoring shopfronts and upgrading public spaces such as footpaths, crossovers, bins and seating.

Completed works include:

- Pedestrian crossings
- Footpath upgrades
- Underground powerlines
- Street lighting
- Shopfront restoration
- Tree planting
- Seating
- Drainage upgrades
- Creation and maintenance of Old Bank Corner
